The cost this Year for Candidates is fixed by Supreme at \$70.00 (Priest Candidates \$ 50.00) The cost for dinner guests for this exemplification will be \$45.00.

The Banquet will begin after the exemplification at La Neve's Restaurant. There will be a cocktail hour after the exemplification. Beer Wine and soda will be available through dinner. There will also be music for dancing and entertainment.

This Exemplification will be limited to 75 Candidates not including Priests. The degree is starting later on a Sunday to accommodate Priests. Each Assembly is encouraged to bring a priest to this degree. *Seating* at the banquet will be on a *FIRST COME FIEST SERVED* basis. The Exemplification will be in honor of Fr. Michael McGivney the role model for Parish Priests.

The size of the exemplification is being controlled due to the limitations of the facilities. We are asking the Assemblies to turn their Form4's in early. The *Faithful Admirals* will be handling the application for the new candidates. I am more than confident that the applications will be filled out properly and submitted in timely fashion. The *Faithful Navigators* will be handling the seating arrangements for their respective Assemblies. I encourage you to get your applications in early. Since we anticipate having more than 250 people at the dinner it is extremely important that this job be handled in a judicious manner.

CANDIDATE INFORMATION

All candidates: MUST be in possession of a VALID (CURRENT SIGNED) 3rd Degree Card and it MUST be shown at registration.

All candidates should know the *NAME* and *NUMBER* of their *ASSEMBLY* they are joining, since registration is in Assembly order.

Dress Code for Candidates *is as follows:* BLACK or MIDNIGHT BLUE TUXEDO, WHITE SHIRT with LAY DOWN COLLAR, (NO WING TIPS OR RUFFLES), BLACK BOW TIE, BLACK SHOES and SOCKS. CUMBERBUN MUST BE BLACK.
